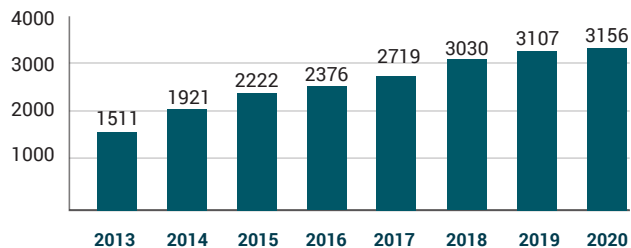

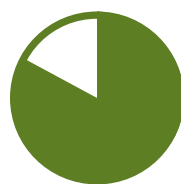

Adapting to Serve



Telehealth

In order to reach those who are isolated and unable to enroll in our inpatient programming, MnTC built a robust infrastructure to provide outpatient telehealth services for those suffering from addiction. Mobile assessments for those incarcerated and virtual counseling sessions were just some of the tools implemented to reach the hurting.



Expanded Women's Facilities

Renovations are underway for our newest building (Former Harriet Tubman Women's Shelter) to be completed summer of 2021 to serve more women in our communities. This 60,000 square foot facility will have an additional 78 beds with larger and more comfortable communal areas, making visits with children and chapel services a more enjoyable and effective experience.



New Programming for Women

There is substantial evidence to show that those who have experienced sexual exploitation have a much higher occurrence of addiction to substances. For this reason, we began partnering with the local nonprofit, Breaking Free, which specializes in caring for women who have been victims of sexual exploitation.



Virtual Prevention Presentations

Our Know the Truth™ Prevention Program, quickly adapted to the restrictions caused by the pandemic and provided virtual presentations, webinars and conferences to students, teachers and community members, reaching more than 40,000 individuals in 2020.

Our mission is to assist men, women and teens in gaining freedom from addictions and other life-controlling problems by addressing their physical, emotional and spiritual needs.
